## Family



Initiatives that strengthen and enhance the lives of children and families in Anne Arundel County.

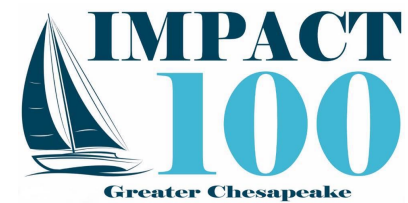
## Health & Wellness

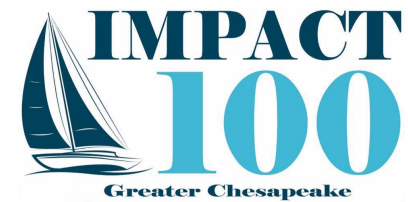

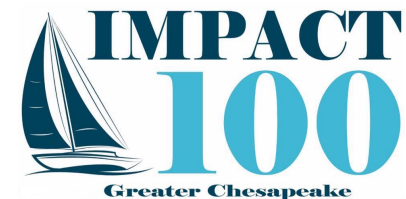

# Grant Stipulations

---

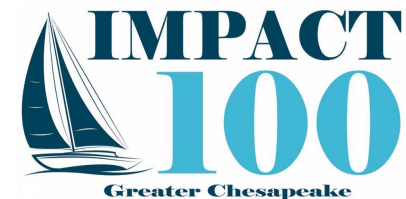
- ❖ Impact100 Greater Chesapeake does NOT provide direct funding to organizations
- ❖ Disburse funds on an as-expended basis
- ❖ Grantees must submit quarterly reports upon implementation and progress of the project
- ❖ Prior to the release of grant funds, each recipient must complete the Impact100 Greater Chesapeake grant agreement form



# Organization Eligibility

---

- ❖ Defined as a tax-exempt public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code – must be able to provide 501(c)(3) status
- ❖ In good standing with the State of Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation
- ❖ Based in, providing services to, or collaborating with organizations in Anne Arundel County
- ❖ Religious-based organizations cannot make religious demands/requirements on community members as part of the project for which they are applying

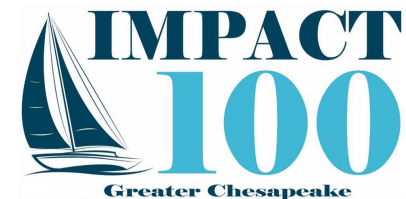


# Project Eligibility

---

## ❖ The project must:

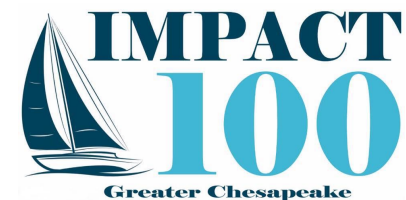
- Serve residents of and expend funds fully in Anne Arundel County
- Be a new program, expansion of an existing program, or be a new/expanded collaborative effort of multiple nonprofit organizations
- Have a total project budget for the full grant award amount (can be over but NOT under)
- Expend all funds within 24 months of grant award



# Impact100 will NOT provide grants for:

---

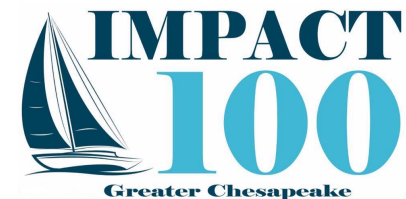
- ❖ General operating expenses or overhead, such as ongoing salaries for existing staff
  - EXCEPTION: A request for items of an operating or overhead nature that are a part of a new or expanded initiative or project. Salaries can be covered by grant funds so long as the salary is paid to someone with significant involvement in the grant project. ***A sustainability plan must be provided in the event the salary is required beyond the grant period.***
- ❖ Debt reduction or operational deficits
- ❖ Interim or bridge funding
- ❖ Grants to individuals
- ❖ Endowment funding
- ❖ Capital improvement or renovations to property for the grant project if the organization does not own or have a lease of at least five years



# Additional Disqualifying Application Errors

---

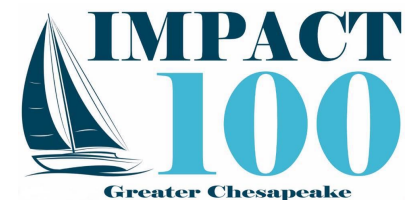
- ❖ More than one application is submitted by a single organization
- ❖ Financial information is missing or incomplete
- ❖ Organization does not demonstrate sustainability or the project does not include a sustainability plan



# Wish Lists

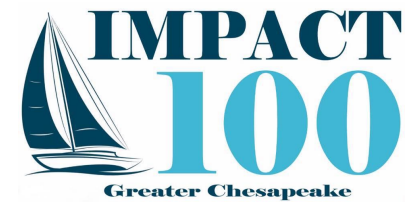
---

- ❖ All applicants will have an opportunity to submit a wish list of items that could benefit their organization. These could be physical items; or a request for Board Members or other individuals who could help your organization such as a webmaster, accountant, etc.

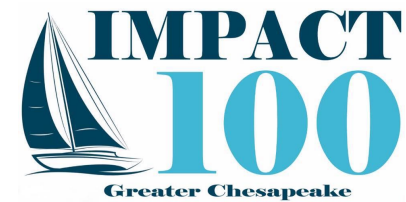

# Recommendations for Strong Project Ideas

---

- ❖ Demonstrates that the project fills a unique need that no other organization is addressing
- ❖ Provides plans to fully expend the grant funds or complete the project in a short timeframe
- ❖ Explains plans for sustainability



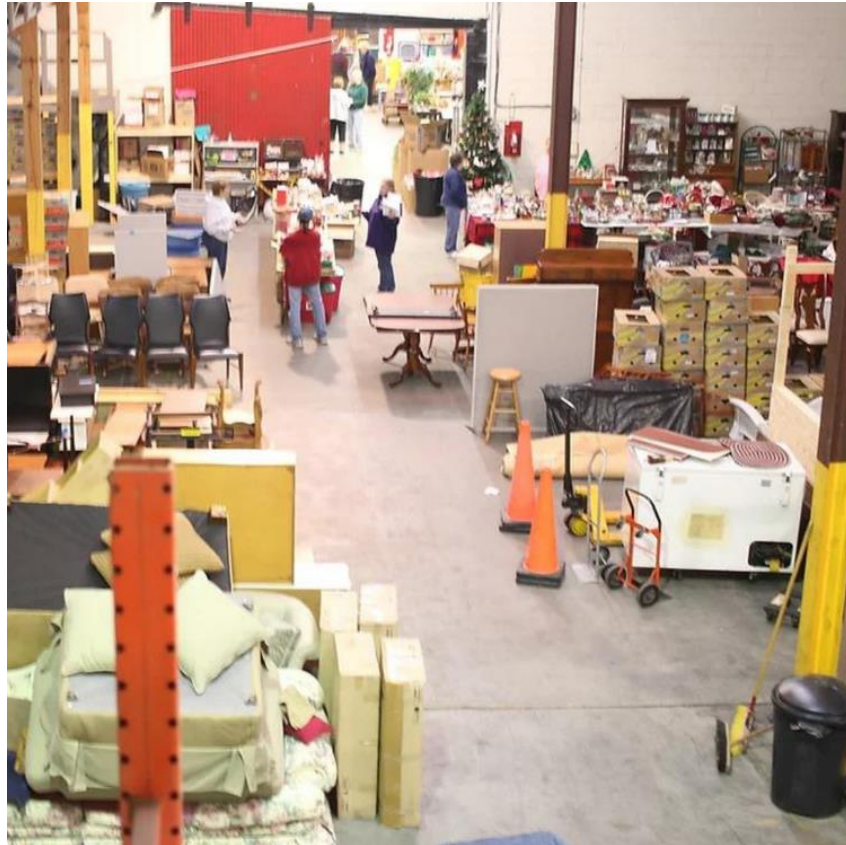
# Past Recipient – 2022



- ❖ Boys and Girls Club Annapolis and Anne Arundel County; \$72,000
  - Purchase and outfitting of a Club on the Go Bus to bring programming to kids in the community who may not have the opportunity to participate in out-of-school-time programming. The bus also assists with a mobile pantry and food resources.

# Past Recipient – 2021

---



## ❖ HOPE For All; \$81,000

- Purchase of a barcoding system and warehouse storage options to reduce the time it takes for them to turn a house into a home by providing beds, furniture, household items, linens, clothing, and more to 300+ families annually.

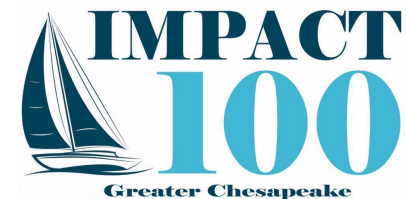
# Past Recipient – 2020

---



## ❖ Rebuilding Together; \$54,000

- Purchase and outfitted a work van to help people return to their homes in a timely and safe manner. As people discharged from rehab, there are hospital-required home upgrades that the organization builds to allow people to return and heal safely in the comfort of their own homes sooner and with the dignity they deserve.



# Past Recipient – 2019

---



- ❖ Anne Arundel County Food Bank;  
\$80,000
  - Purchase an additional refrigerated truck and FDA-approved food storage containers for them to safely store and distribute food throughout the community.

# Past Recipient – 2018

---

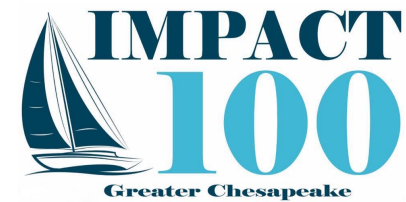


## ❖ Maryland Therapeutic Riding; \$57,000

- Purchase critical vehicles and equipment to enable increased therapeutic participation, community outreach, and enhanced safety and emergency capabilities.

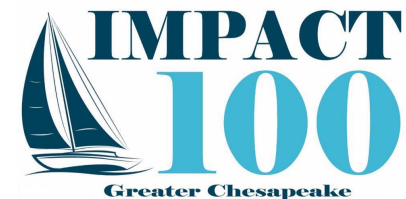

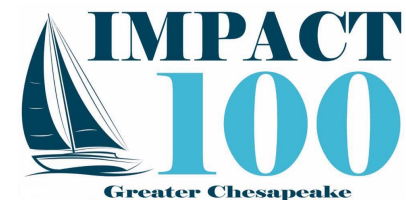




# Recommendations for Strong Grant Applications

---

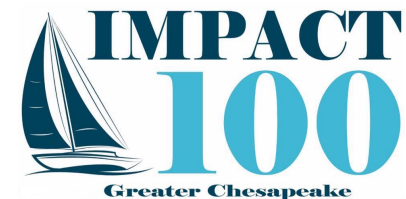
- ❖ Write a clear, concise, and easy to understand application
- ❖ Provide a clear and well-defined budget for your program/project
- ❖ Ensure your program/project falls within the scope of the focus area
- ❖ Provide information regarding past organizational success
- ❖ Demonstrate strength of the board of directors and key personnel
- ❖ Identify the impact of the project



# Best Practices

---

- ❖ Review the PDF-version of the grant application prior to entering information into the online application
- ❖ Double check you have emailed all required attachments to [grants@impact100greaterchesapeake.org](mailto:grants@impact100greaterchesapeake.org) using the proper subject line and file naming conventions
  - Utilize the program/project expenses and revenue template
    - Provide quotes or estimates to support your program/project expenses
- ❖ Utilize the helpful checklist to ensure your application is fully complete
- ❖ Submit your application and required attachments ON TIME, by **June 30, 11:59PM ET** – late submissions will not be considered!

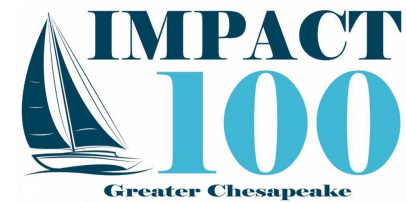
